

NOTICE OF ELECTION

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN, and particularly, to the eligible electors of the Green Mountain Water and Sanitation District (the “District”) in the City of Lakewood, Jefferson County, Colorado:

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of an election to be conducted on Tuesday, May 2, 2017, during which the polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. The Board of Directors of the District has designated the following polling place for the election:

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that an eligible elector of the District for the purpose of said election is a person registered to vote pursuant to the “Uniform Election Code of 1992”; and (i) is a resident of the District, or (ii) who, or whose spouse or civil union partner, owns taxable real or personal property situated within the District, whether said person resides within the District or not. A person who is obligated to pay taxes under a contract to purchase taxable property within the boundaries of the District shall be considered an owner of taxable property for the purpose of qualifying as an eligible elector.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at said election, the eligible electors of the District shall vote on the recall of District Director Thomas H. Stocker and vote on a successor candidate to serve as Director of the District if the recall is successful.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at said election, the eligible electors of the District shall vote on the following ballot questions:

Ballot Question A (Recall of Thomas H. Stocker)
Ballot Question B (Successor Candidate)
